MICHAEL'S FIGHT FOR FULL CUSTODY

In recently filed court papers, Michael Strahan accuses his ex-wife of physical and emotional abuse.

Michael Strahan is the first to admit his 2006 split from wife Jean Muggli wasn't easy. "When you get divorced, people get upset, angry and say crazy things," he shared in 2014. "You have to take it."

But the NFL star-turned-talk show host is seemingly done taking it. In shocking new court papers, Michael, 48, claims that his ex has been engaging in a pattern of abusive conduct towards their twin daughters, Sophia and Isabella, 15, and now he's demanding primary custody of the girls. Legal documents claim that she's the reason the twins have regularly missed their volleyball matches and equestrian events in North Carolina, where they reside with their mother. Worse, the star reportedly has proof of physical and emotional abuse. Now Michael, who has visitation rights, wants the girls to come and live with him in NYC, and
